

TPSC 2-Day Advanced Pistol Course

Class size will be limited to only 16 students.

This course will be an intermediate/advanced level course focusing on rapid target engagement while maintaining an acceptable level of 'combat accuracy.' This is not a basic fundamentals/level 1 course. Shooters will be expected to be proficient in basic marksmanship fundamentals with their handgun to include, stoppage clearance drills, immediate action drills and drawing from a secured holster. Drills will focus on compressing the necessary fundamentals with the goal of achieving a first round hit on target as quickly as possible. This course is a logical extension of the Primary Handgun courses taught at Tac Pro Shooting Center but will allow a much deeper dive into the elements required to make a proficient shooter and provide many more drills/ reps than the Primary Handgun Course.

Students will need the following gear: duty belt with duty holster, handgun, minimum 5 pistol mags and 1200 rounds of handgun ammunition.

Handguns may be equipped with iron sights or an optic. There is no mandate to use a pistol with a red dot optic on it for this class, however many of the drills in

this course are designed to exploit the advantages of a red dot. The use of a red dot is strongly encouraged.

Drills for the pistol will include: Engaging multiple targets; shooting steel and paper targets; multiple plate rack drills, scramblers and movement courses. Target engagement will be from zero to 75 yards with the handgun with some shots possibly taken up to 150 yards on the final 'Jungle Run' drill of the course.
